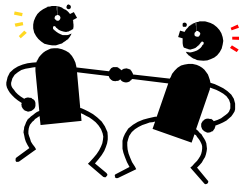

9:00 am Service

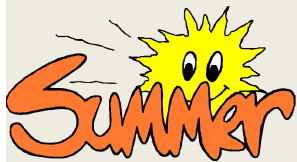
- Nursery: ages 0-2

Wednesday evenings from 7pm to 9:30pm Senior High School youth meet for fun and games, hang-out, worship, teaching and small groups. Once every eight weeks or so we have a coffeehouse where we make a space to share a talent or idea.

KPC Offerings/ Donations



At Kortright, offerings are collected during the services once per month, on the last Sunday. However, you are free to give an offering at any time by depositing your envelope in one of the grey wall boxes at the back of the Sanctuary. You may also sign up for Pre-Authorized Remittance (PAR). Sign-up forms are located on top of the offering boxes. Ask the office if you want donation envelopes.
