DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba wants to help an injured elephant and has a bandage for the children.
- *Bible:* We listened to and then acted out the story Jesus told about the Good Samaritan.
- *Snack:* We ate a graham cracker with a heart so we will remember to love everyone.
- *Craft:* We colored our craft and put a bandage on the hurt man.
- *Game:* We took turns being the hurt man and the Good Samaritan.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Jesus asks us, Will you help? Will you help? Jesus asks us, Will you help? I can and so can you."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 10:29-37

LEARN BY DOING:

Your child can learn to do good works by modeling you. Involve your child in projects that help others. Let child earn some money to put in the offering basket each week. Your child can help you collect food for a less fortunate family or donate some toys to victims of a storm or flood. Ask your child for his/her ideas on how you could help someone else.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- The Samaritan helped a man he did not know.
- We can help people.
- God wants us to be a good neighbor.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
