Take Home Point:

Love everyone.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns to love a neighbor.
- *Bible:* We read a big book about the Good Samaritan and then acted it out.
- *Snack:* We made a love sandwich and gave it to our neighbor.
- *Craft:* We made a necklace to remind us to love everyone.
- *Game:* We played a game called "Love or Not Love?"
- *Singing:* To the tune of *London Bridge*: "Jesus says love everyone, everyone, everyone, Jesus says love everyone, love everyo-ne."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 10:30-37

LEARN BY DOING:

Two-year-olds are naturally self-centered. The best way for them to learn about loving everyone is to make it real for them. Show them how you give money to help various causes; give of your time to help others; give food items to food drives. Reinforce that we do things for others to show our love.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus loves everyone.
- We should love everyone, even people we don't know.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
